Reporting Day- 29.10.2023

As we planned and mentioned in the camp invitation letter, all the management staffs and volunteers will be reported in the camp by 29.10.2023 morning and all the campers may come before 5 pm on the same day. In this connection, all the managerial staffs and distance areas district campers are come to the camp timely and registered at the camp office. After the registration, all the camper had assemble in front of the stage area and take introduction, background etc to us.

Shri Som, Camp Coordinator of the camp took the session specifically regarding the rules and regulation of the camp, daily schedule, and duty distribution, everything discussed at well manner to all the campers. Esteemed Camp Director our beloved Madhu Bhai addressed all the management rules and regulations to all. Then all are going to their dinner at kitchen area.

Inaugural Day- 30.10.2023

On the 1st day of camp, all the participants woke up at 4.55 a.m. and they were asked to gather in the field by 5 a.m., which was coordinated by som bhai. In the Next and Inaugural Session, the CO-FOUNDER of CYSD Dr. Jagadananda Sir inaugurated the camp. All the guests were honored and delivered their speeches. Guest Speaker Dr Dillip Srichandan, Ex- MLA, Khordha and Founder Prerana spoke about their student carrier to political and social carrier, and then CDAO, Khordha spoke about agricultural development in khordha district, Mr Madhusudan Das, National Youth Project, and Odisha spoke about advantage of the Rebuild Odisha Campaign to all campers. At last, Project Point Advisor Mr Arjun Pradhan discussed about pillars of growth and students life in rural area. In this point of connection, College Principal said about the Students love to the campus and Education. Overly, all the inaugural session presiding by Dr Sangram keshari Samantaray, Chairperson of Project Point and Vote of thanks by Shri Som, Chairperson of the ABFT.

Then all the stalls (Maa Santoshi SHG Group, Millet Food Festival, Mission Sakti, and Project Point) were inaugurated. Then we had our lunch and went for the next session. In this session, Madhu Bhai honored UNICEF'S Staff Mr. Khan Sir (RP). He explained some of the important points like WASH, Climate Change, Change Maker and how to maintain proper hygiene in schools and Anganwadi. Miss Smruti Swain, Coordinator of Y4Water Plus awareness about the campaign and media engagement and registered all the participants through the Y4W Plus campaign. All the participants are coming with the mission and take charge of the district as ambassador. Sangram Bhai ended this session with vote of thanks.

The Next Session was started from 3:30 P.M and conducted for an hour. The RP of the session were and **Sri Nihar Ranjan Dash, OAS (SS) (Special Secretary to govt. Public enterprises dept., Govt. of Odisha)** and the topic was **Challenges of Odisha (climate, governance and development)**. Som Bhai gave vote of thanks for this session. Then we went for the last session of the day where **Dr. Rashmi kar (Advisor of Project Point)** and **Madhu Bhai (State Convener of NYP)** attended the session. Madhu Bhai with his pleasing voice started this session with a beautiful prayer Sarba Dharma Prathana in the prayer class, which was song, and the prayer was energetic. Then we went for the cultural program performed by the camp mates, and we concluded our Day 1 at camp.

Second Day- 31.10.2023

Environment. After the session completion, we had a paper presentation with all Guest RPs and participants. At 6:30 P.M. we went for the evening prayer in the presence of **Dr. Biswamohan Jena, OES-I (Programme Coordinator, NSS Bureau, CHSE, Odisha Bhubaneswar)** and **PO of Revenshaw Junior College.** After we are done with our prayers, we went to attend the cultural function @7 P.M where **Mr Sukanta Mangaraj (Ex- Zilla Parishad Member)** was invited as a guest. With that, we ended the Day 2 of the camp successfully with every event on time.

Third Day- 01.11.2023

So, the day 3 was started with the same morning schedule as day 2 where we gathered at the field and sang the **Nau jaban Ao re song** with madhu bhai and then went for workout sessions with **Mr. Ramesh Sahoo**, Patanjali Yoga Samiti and then went for the flag hoisting where **Mr. Vipin Kumar (District Youth Officer, Nehru Yuva Kendra, Khordha)** was invited as a guest. After flag hoisting, we went for a rally from campsite to kamaguru village with all the participants and sang the youth song with the slogan “**Ame banchiba odisha pain re, Ame mariba odisha pain re**”. The Community engagement rally was most powerful in the camp. Because, all the campers and village communities have their discussion about village development. After we returned from the rally, we had a session with Madhusudan Das regarding connection with Rebuild concept. Here there was 4 Rebuild concept discussed by 4 nos of Panelist which was nominated by madhu bhai at that time of session. Miss Pooja, Arupa, Ranee and Surya Bhai continued their presentation and Group discussion at the end. Overall discussion may headed by Reeta Apa, ZP member of Anugul and Pad Girl of Odisha Miss Patel. After the Group discussion, all the 4 groups presented their village concept to Rebuild mission. At last Sangram Bhai conclude the session with overall mark. After the session, we completed our daily routines and went to attend the next session. In this session, the topic of discussion was **clean and green village**, and the RP of the session was **Sankuli Biswal**. In the following session, we discussed some of the key points such as:

- Water Resource
- Plastic Waste Management
- Soak pit ,Compost Pit and Leach Pit

Session was concluded with vote of thanks by Som Bhai and then us to attend a workshop on **Rebuild Odisha**. The RP of the session was **Mr. Madhusudan Das, National Trustee, and National Youth Project & Rebuild Odisha Concept Founder**. He gave a very informative presentation and after we completed presentation, we had our lunch break and made us prepared for the next session. This session started around 2:30 P.M. and continued until 3 P.M., this was a short session but informative. The session RP was **Mr. Prahallad Singh (Eminent gandhian)** on the topic **Gandhian philosophy and traditional way of leaving by father of nation**, **Dr Md Imran Ali**, **Mr Karunakar Dalsingray, Sarpanch of Garhmantir GP** and **Prof. Sashikant Panigrahi (Advisor BAHAI’S)**, and the topic of discussion was **Peace and Harmony in India**.

We had a great workshop; we really enjoyed and understood a lot many concepts with so much of clarity. As every day, we went for the evening prayer to the prayer class, we had **Mr Debraj Senapati, Ex- Sub Collector of Khordha** as guest, and as usual, the prayer **Sarba Dharma Prathana** was so pleasing. After the prayer class we went to attend the cultural event where and **Sarpanch Deuli GP** were invited as guest. In addition, with this, we concluded the 3rd day at the campsites.

Last Day- 02.11.2023

Here we are with the fourth or last day of the camp. We started the day in the same fashion by gathering at the field and singing the **Nau jaban Ao re song** with Madhu bhai. Then we went for our exercise session with som bhai. At 7 am, we went for the flag hoisting and the guest of the moment was Miss Reeta Apa from Talcher Zilla Parishad. Then we had our breakfast, completed our daily routines, and went for the topic: **Blood donation drive & promotion**, which was presented by **Dr Debasish Mishra, Director, Capital blood bank, Bhubaneswar & Mission Raktadan team.**

After making our contribution in the blood donation drive, we had a **quiz competition on climate change**, and we had many key takeaways as well in the quiz session. The session RP was **Prasamit Kanungo, Youth leaders council member, Y4water plus.** Then we had second last session of the day and the camp by **Dr. Manoj Dash, Director, Odisha dialogues** and the topic of the discussion was **Odisha development.**

The last day was short, as we had to close the day by 1:30 p.m., so we had the **Closing ceremony** of 2hrs where all participants, camp mates were present. we made a lot of memories in this 4days, and it was almost a heart broken moment for all of us as we are going to miss a lot many things of the camp, the friends, the leaders, the daily activities, that busy schedules, etc. the closing function was really good and that's how we ended the 4th or final day of the camp.
